BYLAW NO. 81-30

A bylaw to compel the abatement of activities
creating noise in the Town of Drayton Valley.

Whereas Section 157(1)(g) of the Municipal Government Act provides that the council of a municipality may pass bylaws for the purpose of prohibiting, eliminating, or abating noise, and establishing permissible noise levels for all or various periods of the day, in all or designated parts or locations of the municipality. Now, therefore, the council of the Town of Drayton Valley enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as the noise bylaw.

2. GENERAL PROHIBITION

- (a) No person shall make or continue any loud unnecessary or unusual noise which disturbs the comfort, repose of other persons within the town limits except to the extent permitted by this bylaw.
- (b) No person shall allow property belonging to him or under his control to be used so that there originates from the property any loud, unnecessary or unusual noise which disturbs the comfort or repose of other persons in the vicinity of such property or generally within the limits of the town.
- (c) What is a loud noise, an unnecessary noise, an unusual noise or a noise which disturbs the comfort or repose of other persons is a question of fact for a court which hears a prosecution of an offence against this bylaw.

3. AN ABATEMENT OF NOISE


- (a) No person shall within the corporate limits of the Town of Drayton Valley make, or cause to be made any unnecessary or unusual noise likely to disturb the peace and quiet of the community, unless permission to do so was first obtained in writing from the council.

4. PENALTIES


- (a) A person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw either by doing something which he is prohibited from doing or failing to do something which he is required to do, is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not in excess of \$500 (five hundred dollars) or in default of the fine to imprisonment.






