

TOWN OF DRAYTON VALLEY

BYLAW 92-12

Being a Bylaw of the Town of Drayton Valley in the Province of Alberta to amend Bylaw 81-30, being a bylaw to compel the abatement of activities creating noise in the Town of Drayton Valley.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the Town of Drayton Valley, in the Province of Alberta, has the authority pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980 and amendments thereto, to pass bylaws for the purpose of prohibiting, eliminating or abating noise, and establishing permissible noise levels for all or various periods of the day, in all or designated parts or locations of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS, the purpose of Bylaw 81-30 is to compel the abatement of activities creating noise in the Town of Drayton Valley;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Drayton Valley, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:


1. That Section 4 of Bylaw 81-30 be revised as follows:

4. PENALTIES

- a) A municipal tag or ticket in the amount of the voluntary penalty will be issued for any breach of this bylaw.
- b) In the event a municipal tag remains unpaid after a period of fourteen (14) days a summons will be issued.
- c) Any person who commits a breach of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to a voluntary penalty of:
 - i) For the first offense to a voluntary penalty of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and upon Summary Conviction to a fine of not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars and in default of payment to a term of imprisonment of six (6) months or to both.
 - ii) For a second and subsequent offense to a voluntary penalty of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars and upon Summary conviction to a fine of not more than One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars and in default of payment to a term of imprisonment of six (6) months or to both.
- d) Once a first offense has been filed, the file will remain active for a two year period, after which the file will be closed. Any offenses that occur after the two year period will be treated as a first offense.

This Bylaw shall come into force and have effect from and after the date of third reading thereof.
