## UPDATE

Work on the creation of Drayton Valley's Bio-Mile has taken another step forward with the appointment of a full time co-ordinator.

Patty Piironen is a long-time resident of the Drayton Valley area. She brings with her a very strong background in economic development and an in depth knowledge of the forestry industry. Patty, who started work last month, will be working alongside Town council and administration to co-ordinate the future direction of the Bio-Mile project. Meanwhile the site of the Bio-Mile's first new development has been leveled and landscaped. The site is located toward the south end of Drayton Valley, on the west side of 50 Street opposite Sekura Auctions. It will be home to an engineered fibre matting plant which will be operated by TTS, an Edmonton based company. Construction is expected to be completed next year. Also in the same location, and currently under construction, is the Bio-Mile interpretive centre. The building will showcase some of the practical applications of the kind of sustainable technology TTS is working on.

**Bylaw No. 2000-09 - Miscellaneous**
