THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS APPLY FOR THE PLACEMENT OF ANY TEMPORARY PORTABLE SIGN (INCLUDING SANDWICH-BOARD OR A-FRAME SIGNS, STAKED SIGNS, AND REMOVABLE COPY SIGNS). HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS A "TEMPORARY SIGN":

- **Temporary signage shall not be permitted to be located on Town lands, including boulevards and streets.**
- Temporary signage shall not contain content of a sensitive nature. Any complaints received by the Town as to the content of any portable sign shall be subject to removal at the Town Administration's discretion.
- No temporary signage shall be placed on any sign pad without an approved Development Permit.
- No temporary signage shall be permitted within the boundaries of the Town unless located on privately owned property, and with a Development Permit approved by the Town.
- All temporary signage shall be marked so as to identify ownership.
- All temporary signage shall be maintained by the owner in an aesthetically pleasing manner, subject to the Town's approval.
- **Temporary signage is approved as noted above and in accordance with the attached photographs delineating the site, sign appearance and sign dimensions.**
- **A one-time fee of \$25.00 applies to this permit, which shall apply to the above approved sign(s) and location(s). Any change to the dimension of the sign, or its placement, is subject to a new/separate permit approval.**
