The Town of Drayton Valley acquires a new animal control facility

DRAYTON VALLEY- The Town of Drayton Valley has come to an agreement to purchase the former Associated Ambulance Building in Drayton Valley to be the new home of animal control and shelter operations.

Through the 2015 and 2016 capital budget process Council and Administration have reached an agreement to purchase and retrofit the building to meet the needs of animal shelter operations.

“The Town of Drayton Valley is dedicated to have a safe, secure and accessible place for animal control and temporary sheltering purposes in the community,” says Mayor Glenn Mclean.

Following the finalization of the purchase, a request for proposals for animal control services will be issued. The process will look to find a person, group or organization to utilize the new facility for temporary housing and care of found and apprehended animals.

The acquisition of this building is in keeping with a caring community and looking to improve quality of life and services for the residents of the Town of Drayton Valley.
