

FUNDS ALLOCATED FOR SAFE AND HEALTHY COMMUNITY INITIATIVES

February 22nd, 2017

DRAYTON VALLEY-During the February 22nd, 2017 meeting of Town Council approved funding from the Safe and Healthy Community Allocation Fund for the following applicants:

- The Warming Hearts Soup Kitchen for the coupon program in the amount of \$11,975.
- Drayton Valley Lions Club in the amount of \$1,400 for the support of activities within the Town of Drayton Valley.
- The Drayton Valley Health Services Foundation in the amount of \$5,000 in support of the Family Fun Night activities that occur as part of the Festival of Trees.
- Brighter Futures and the Pembina Crisis Connection Society's family violence awareness workshop in the amount of \$1,600.
- The Pembina Crisis Connection Society in the amount of \$2,500 in support of the workshop "Tattered Teddies".
- Council has also provided a pledge of support towards the Baby Essentials Program offered by Brighter Futures.

As outlined in the policy, funding received from Automated Traffic Enforcement (ATE) will be held in reserves and allocated to initiatives or programs that contribute to a safe and healthy community within the Town of Drayton Valley.
