New carts will be delivered to your door and the old ones will be collected

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

GARBAGE COLLECTION

WILL A NEW WASTE CART BE PROVIDED TO ME?

- Yes, new carts will be delivered to your home by Can Pak Environmental Inc.
- The delivery of carts will begin in late December and continue through the month of January until all the waste carts are delivered

DO I HAVE TO PAY FOR THE NEW WASTE CART?

- No, new carts will be provided to all eligible single family residential customer units

WHAT DO I DO WITH MY OLD CART

- You can continue to use your old waste cart until your new cart is delivered

WHAT IF MY NEW WASTE CART IS BROKEN?

- Your waste cart will be replaced or repaired if they are stolen, or damaged by the collection truck while being emptied. Please contact Can Pak Environmental Inc. at 780-515-8999 to report the problem

CAN I LABEL OUR WASTE CART SO I CAN IDENTIFY IT?

- Write your address on the side of the totes with a permanent marker. This will help identify your cart if they ever go missing or need repairs
- Do NOT put your name on the totes as they are assigned to this specific address

RECYCLING

IS THERE A LIMIT TO THE NUMBER OF BLUE BAGS ALLOWED?

- There is no limit to the amount of recyclables

RECYCLING OPTIONS FOR YOU BLUE BAGS

- Blue bags allow collection crews to easily see that the materials in the bag are allowable recyclables and not other material that would contaminate the recyclables. If recyclables are contaminated, they are considered waste and must be landfilled

RECYCLING CONTAINER

- Recyclable materials can also be placed into a clearly identifiable recycling container and placed at your pickup area for collection

RECYCLING TIPS

CARDBOARD

- Flattened corrugated cardboard boxes must be no larger than 36 inches square

SHREDDED PAPER

- Shredded paper is acceptable in your blue bags

OTHER RECYCLABLES

- Don't forget to empty and rinse your recyclable containers

SCHEDULE/ COLLECTION

WHAT TO DO ON COLLECTION DAY PLACEMENT

- Place your cart so that there is at least 1 metre (3 ft) of space between your carts and other objects (e.g. parked cars, power poles, utility boxes)
- Leave 3 meters (10 ft) of space above the carts. If carts are placed underneath a tree, or power line they cannot be collected safely
- Garbage and recycling must be set out for collection by 7:00 am
- Place your your cart so the arrow on the lid points toward the street/alley
- Please remove your carts by 9:00 pm

WITH THIS CHANGE, WILL MY COLLECTION DATE BE CHANGING? GARBAGE COLLECTION

- Your garbage will be picked up every week on your same collection day
- ### RECYCLING COLLECTION
- Your recycling will be picked up every second week with your garbage

I'M MOVING TO A NEW HOME IN A FEW MONTHS. DOES OUR WASTE CART MOVE WITH US IF WE MOVE?

- Please do not take your cart with you. They remain the property of the Town of Drayton Valley and are assigned to residences rather than people

I JUST MOVED TO DRAYTON VALLEY, HOW DO I GET MY WASTE CART?
