

Relief funding going to be available from the Province of Alberta and the Red Cross in Drayton Valley

May 11th, 2016

DRAYTON VALLEY- The Town of Drayton Valley has received over 250 evacuees to our area over the last week. The Reception Centre at the Drayton Valley Omniplex is available for all evacuees arriving to our community.

The provincial government will be providing relief funding to individuals affected by the wildfire evacuation in Fort McMurray in the amounts of \$1250 for individuals and \$500 for each dependent. For more information on the way to access funding go to: http://www.alberta.ca/emergency.cfm

The distribution of emergency financial assistance from Red Cross begins today and will be provided to evacuees in a number of different ways – including electronic banking transfers through email, money orders, cash cards, or vouchers – depending on people's current location in Canada and the quickest, most secure way to receive these funds.

We are also encouraging all evacuees to check-in at the reception center daily for updates.
