

Alleged act of vandalism lead to disruption of activities at Omni I and Total Works Fitness Centre on Saturday, March 3, 2018

On the evening of March 2, 2018, a sprinkler pipe burst in the Omniplex, causing significant flooding in the lower level of the Total Works Fitness Centre. Once the cause of the damages was determined, the RCMP were called in to investigate an alleged act of vandalism.

Omni I and Total Works Fitness Centre were closed to the public Saturday morning until the damage could be assessed and public safety could be ensured. This unexpected closure forced a number of events to be canceled in Omni I and disrupted activities at the Fitness Centre.

The main and upper levels of the Fitness Centre were not affected and are open to the public. The lower level will remain closed until further notice which includes the free weight room and racquetball/squash courts; fitness classes have also been suspended until the necessary repairs have been completed.

Omniplex management and staff recognize the inconvenience this has caused their patrons and are working diligently to bring the lower level of the Fitness Centre to a safe and operable condition for the public.
