



DRAYTON VALLEY MUNICIPAL LIBRARY (DVML) BOARD

Purpose/Mandate:

The Drayton Valley Municipal Library has been operating for over 60 years, and is governed by the DVML Board. The Board is enacted under the Town of Drayton Valley Bylaw #99-15. The Board is responsible for the Drayton Valley Municipal Library, Rotary Children's Library, and Words on Wheels van which does library programs in the community.

The Library Board has legal responsibilities and many learning opportunities. It is a governance board that meets, on average, once a month. It is given authority through the *Alberta Libraries Act*. DVML serves residents in the Town of Drayton Valley and Brazeau County. Major funding partners are the Town of Drayton Valley and Brazeau County.
