



Eavor Technologies Inc, a tech company dedicated to creating a cleaner energy future, has been working with multi-levels of government and private network partners towards the building of the **World's First Commercial Eavor-Loop™ project in Drayton Valley.**

Eavor-Loop™ is a new way of creating electricity by harnessing power from the Earth's natural geological temperature. This project uses geothermal technology to generate electricity and/or thermal energy but makes it scalable by removing the need for volcanic-type temperatures, or permeable aquifers. The geological conditions and the local knowledge and skillset of directional drilling in the Brazeau County / Drayton Valley area, creates an ideal situation for this project.

The Town of Drayton Valley has a low risk opportunity to support a new and innovative technology through a grant application and if the project proves successful, the Town and County will be in partnership to provide electricity and/or thermal power utility to area residents and businesses. This project will provide Drayton Valley the chance be noticed on the map internationally, as well as create an income base for both the Town and County.
