

## DOLLARS ALLOCATED FROM SAFE AND HEALTHY COMMUNITY ALLOCATION FUND

**DRAYTON VALLEY**-On Wednesday January 11<sup>th</sup>, 2017, a special meeting of Town Council was held to approve funding from the Safe and Healthy Community Allocation Fund. The successful applicants are:

- Aim for Success's "I am Empowered" Women's conference March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2017 that will be held at the Clean Energy and Technology Centre that will consist of a number of workshops, guest speakers and activities toward building confident and strong women. The amount approved is \$6,000.
- Pembina Crisis Connection Society to host a workshop designed to educate attendee's on racism and resilience and how to combat it. The workshop will be facilitated by the Centre for Race and Culture. The amount approved is \$2,225.

Council led its decision based on the timeliness of these events and all remaining applications and proposals received are still under review and pending decision at a future date

As outlined in the policy, funding received from Automated Traffic Enforcement (ATE) will be held in reserves and allocated to Town of Drayton Valley initiatives or programs that contribute to a safe and healthy community.
