



Preparations, including removing existing fences, and ditch stripping have begun for the work scheduled on 62 Street (RR75). The road improvements, from 56 Ave to the Town Boundary, will include a total reconstruction of the existing roadway and replacing current materials with a better-quality clay to build the road base. It will then be topped with cement stabilized sub-base and gravel. Ditches and drainage will also be improved.

Identified by Town Council as part of the 2019 budget, this Capital Project is being done to enhance the road structure and facilitate future growth in the area.

Work is expected to be completed by mid October but is weather dependent. Construction is being done in two parts to minimize disruption however the public may experience road closures and delays while this work is being completed. We ask that you please drive cautiously when you see crews working!
