## Business Administration

### Program Overview

Build the skills you need to thrive in a dynamic business world and choose from five specializations in the second year—Management (entrepreneurship or business operations), Accounting, Human Resources Management, Finance, or General Studies—in which you will develop a core understanding of business fundamentals for any career you choose.

### Career Potential

Graduates of the Business Administration program may find employment in the private or public sector, in small business, government, banking, insurance, not-for-profit organizations, retail, hospitality, oilfield, construction, and other industries.

### Admission Requirements

- 50% in English Language Arts 30-1 or English Language Arts 30-2 or completion of [ESLG 1898](#) with a minimum 50% or equivalent
- 65% in Mathematics 20-1 or Mathematics 20-2 or equivalent, or 50% in Mathematics 30-1 or Mathematics 30-2 or equivalent

### ELP Requirements

If English is your second language, you must provide proof of English language proficiency (ELP) prior to admission. ELP test results must have been obtained within two years of the start date of your program.

Acceptable evidence of ELP may be one of the following test scores:

- CLBA: no section score below 7
- IELTS Academic: 6; no section score below 5.5
- TOEFL iBT: 71
- CELPIP General: 7; no section score below 6
- CAEL: 60
- minimum of 80% in [ESLS 7000](#) or [ESLS 7100](#) (or [ESLG 2101](#)), and 80% in [ESLW 7000](#) or [ESLW 7100](#) (or [ESLG 2103](#))

**Note:** ELP is a separate requirement from the English academic admission requirement.
