COUNCIL DECISION ITEMS

AMENDING BYLAW 2020/08/F - AMENDMENT OF TOWN OF DRAYTON VALLEY BORROWING BYLAW 99-14

In October 1999, Town Council passed Bylaw 99-14 to address the highly seasonal nature of Town revenues. At that time, a borrowing limit of \$750,000.00 was approved to meet current expenditures and obligations of the Town until such a time that taxes could be collected. In 2017, an amendment was made to increase the borrowing limit to \$4,000,000.00, however in light of the current economic situation, it is necessary to make another amendment from \$4,000,000.00 to an amount not exceeding \$9,000,000.00. This will ensure funds are available to maintain operations and capital commitments throughout the year.

This Bylaw was presented for Third and Final Reading and Council carried the Bylaw as presented.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT AMENDING (MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS) BYLAW 2020/10/P PRESENTED FOR FIRST READING

A request to amend the speed limit on Madsen Avenue near the hospital was presented to Council. Amending Bylaw 2020/10/P will change the speed limit along Madsen Ave from 47 Street to 39 Avenue to 30 km/h and ensure it becomes part of Traffic Bylaw 2016/03/P Schedule A. Amending this Bylaw will also ensure the correct descriptions of all non-playground or school speed zones in the town.

Council gave first reading to this bylaw, and changes will now be advertised for a minimum of two weeks before returning to Council on July 15th, 2020 for the Public Hearing and the Second and Third Readings.

COUNCIL DECISION ITEMS

NORTH-WEST (NW) ALBERTA ELECTRIC VEHICLE (EV) CHARGING NETWORK INITIATIVE

On May 25, 2020, the Town received a letter from the Mayor of Edson requesting support and endorsement for a regional collaboration for a North-West (NW) Alberta Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Network. The goal is to promote regional long-term economic growth and tourism as well as connect the region to the rest of AB and BC. The Town already has two EV chargers at the Ramada Hotel and the Foundation Dealership and could leverage future educational and tourism opportunities with the NW Alberta initiative.

Administration sought Council's decision to positively respond to the Mayor of Edson's request and Council approved the motion to proceed with the North-West Alberta Electric Vehicle Charging Network Initiative.

PROPOSED DRAYTON VALLEY BENCH DEDICATION PROGRAM POLICY CS-01-20

Town Council requested that Administration develop a policy for memorial contributions received to honour, remember, and pay tribute to a person or event. The proposed policy addresses the manner in which a dedication plaque can be made and the Town's authority to manage the program. Administration also presented a fee structure for the program.

The draft Bench Dedication program was presented for Council's review and Council approved the Policy as presented.

SPECIALIZED TRANSPORTATION RFP 02-2020/02-C

The Town has been working with the Drayton Valley Community Bus Association as well as other stakeholders to obtain adequate funds for the purchase of a wheelchair accessible van. In March of 2020, the Bus Association received a grant of \$47,204 from the province's Community Initiatives Program. With additional funds from the Bus Association, the Drayton Valley Lamplighters, the Drayton Valley Community Foundation, and FCSS, there is adequate funding for the purchase of a Handi Van with the required amenities.

The Specialized Transportation program is based on a non-municipal entity operating the service, but the Handi Van will be under the Town's ownership, with a lease agreement with the operator. An RFP has been prepared to secure an appropriate and qualified operator and was presented to Council and the Request for Proposal was approved.

PROPOSED 2020 PURCHASING AND TENDERING POLICY

To accommodate Town Council's initiative to 'Get Drayton Valley Back to Work,' Administration requested Council's approval to prepare a policy which would allow for the procurement of local resources to complete infrastructure maintenance and repairs in 2020 and future years. The Proposed 2020 Purchasing and Tendering Policy TF-01-20 will allow for the CAO or his/her designate the ability to manage and adjudicate capital and operational projects as part of Town Council's initiative as well as the potential projects being funded from the Province's "Shovel Ready Projects."

The Proposed Policy was presented to Council and Council approved the preparation of the Proposed 2020 Purchasing and Tendering Policy.
