As part of the Town's "Get Drayton Valley Back to Work" initiative, many seasonal maintenance activities are being completed by local contractors! Included in the list of maintenance work is sewer line flushing, and you may have noticed this underway over the last week.

The Town's sewer systems are flushed on a yearly basis to clean dirt, sediment and any debris out of the lines. This ensures our systems remain clean and help to prevent sewer back-ups! Sewer flushing will continue over the coming days.

COUNCIL DECISION ITEMS

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT AMENDING (MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS) BYLAW 2020/10/P PRESENTED FOR SECOND & THIRD READING

A request was made to amend the speed limit on Madsen Ave from 47 Street to 39 Avenue to 30 km/hr. This Amending Bylaw will ensure that this change becomes part of Traffic Bylaw 2016/03/P Schedule A. In addition, this Bylaw was presented to update and ensure the correct description of all non-playground or school speed zones within the Town of Drayton Valley. Following the Public Hearing, Amending Bylaw 2020/10/P was presented for Second and Third Reading, and Council carried the motion with an amendment to extend the section of road from 47 Street to 38 Avenue.

UTILITY AMENDING BYLAW 2020/11/E PRESENTED FOR FIRST READING

Administration is proposing to amend the current Utility Bylaw to include a clause in the Water Service Charges and Rates section as well as to include a Grease Traps section. Council gave First Reading to this Bylaw, and it will now be advertised for a minimum of two weeks and return to Council on August 19th, 2020 for a Public Hearing and Second and Third Reading.

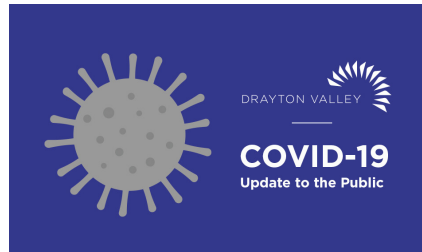

COUNCIL DECISION ITEMS

COMMUNITY GRANTS THIRD QUARTER ALLOCATION

Each quarter, the Town of Drayton Valley grants funding to non-profit organizations to help support their efforts for community projects, programs, and services. Two eligible applications were received and Council granted \$3,000 to the Drayton Valley Community Foundation to help cover the costs of the DV 100, and awarded \$5,750 to the Drayton Valley Pro Rodeo Society to help cover costs associated with the rodeo being held on August 28-30, 2020.

SUSTAINABILITY COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION ON RECYCLING PICK-UP

As there has not been an increase in recycling tonnage since weekly blue bag pick-up commenced, the Sustainability Committee discussed whether to continue the weekly service, or introduce a bi-weekly service. Council considered all options and passed a motion to continue with regular weekly pick-up for recycling.
