BRAZEAU COUNTY LETTER RE: RECREATION COST SHARING

Mayor Doerksen and Town Council received a letter from Brazeau County dated September 21st, 2020 which informed Town Council of the County Council's motion to set the County's 2020 recreation cost-sharing contribution to \$58.49 per capita or \$454,584.28, an unanticipated change in the funding agreement. The letter was presented for Council's direction and Town Council directed Administration to draft a response letter to Brazeau County regarding the Recreation Cost Sharing.

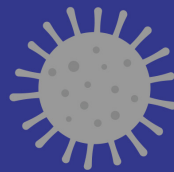
