The Town of Drayton Valley is taking the COVID-19 pandemic seriously and are following the advice and safety measures from Alberta Health Services and will be following the mandates from the Government of Alberta as well as the Government of Canada in order to mitigate the spread of the virus.

As of May 5, 2021, additional COVID-19 health restrictions came into effect for regions with at least 50 cases per 100,000 people and at least 30 active cases. This includes Brazeau County.

# **CIVIC CENTRE**

The Civic Centre is open to the public with regular hours! Visit us Mon-Fri, 8:30 am to 5:00 pm!

- Plexi-glass has been installed at public interfacing areas
- Physical distancing markers have been installed on the floor to help patrons stay 2 metres apart.
- Hand sanitizer will be made available for staff and public
- Surfaces including counter tops, and pin pads will be disinfected after each use
- Signage will be posted to detail physical distancing measures, proper use of masks, and do not enter information should you feel ill

# THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC HEALTH MANDATES ARE STILL IN PLACE:



# PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Keeping a physical distance of 2 metres between you and others outside your household



# **PERSONAL HYGIENE**

Diligent personal hygiene including frequent hand washing, sneezing/coughing into your elbow and staying home when sick remain imperative



# **OUTDOOR GATHERINGS**

A maximum of 5 people are permitted for outdoor social gatherings with physical distancing measures in place.



# **MASK USE**

Use of a face mask is strongly encouraged in areas where you are unable to maintain 2 metres of physical distance.
