RENEWAL: DECLARATION OF STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS on May 4, 2023, a local emergency existed in the Town of Drayton Valley due to the RR64/Buck Creek Fire that threatened people and property within the Town of Drayton Valley.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 21 of the *Emergency Management Act*, and Section 32 of the *Town of Drayton Valley Municipal Emergency Advisory Committee and Agency Bylaw 2019/16/P*, on May 16, 2023 Town of Drayton Valley Council made a renewal of the declaration of a State of Local Emergency within the entirety of the Town of Drayton Valley.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 22 of the *Emergency Management Act* and Section 42 of *Town of Drayton Valley Municipal Emergency Advisory Committee and Agency Bylaw 2019/16/P*, the declaration of a State of Local Emergency lapses 7 days after its making by the local authority unless it is earlier cancelled by the Minister or terminated by the Local Authority or unless it is renewed by the local authority;

WHEREAS the local emergency continues to exist as the wildfire continues to remain out of control;

THEREFORE the state of local emergency is renewed as of today, May 15, 2023 for a period of 7 days ending May 22, 2023.
